US West Coast Ports Halt Work for 4 Days

Dear Valued Customer,

Terminal operators at the West Coast ports will halt vessel loading and unloading on four of the next five days: Thursday (Lincoln's Birthday), Saturday, Sunday and Monday (Washington's Birthday). Yard, gate and rail operations will continue at the discretion of each terminal operator.

The [announcement](#) was made on Wednesday by the Pacific Maritime Association (PMA), which represents terminal operators at West Coast ports.

APL will temporarily suspend the release of empty containers at inland locations for export cargo via the West Coast ports. Shippers should expect further delays as a result of the stoppage. APL will continue to monitor the situation and will provide an update on services, vessels and voyages impacted as information becomes available.
